**MITEY MITES:** The Mitey Mite program is an introductory race program designed for ages 6, 7 & 8 with basic skiing skills in search of a learning experience that will develop an great all around skier. Mitey Mites members are taught skiing fundamentals and racing technique according to their age and ability. Mitey Mites spend most of their time learning by free skiing with experienced coaches and 20% of the time gate training. We keep skiing and learning FUN! You may choose either the basic Saturday or Sunday program.

**Development Team:** Is for ages 9 and over in who want to learn racing technique and become a well rounded skier. Development Team members are taught skiing and racing fundamentals and participate in the BBSEF Coaches Cup race series. Devo members spend 70% of their time learning by free skiing with experienced coaches and 30% of the time gate training. Our goal is to develop well rounded all mountain skiers with a passion for the sport, while having fun. You may choose to participate in the Saturday or Sunday program.

Is your racer interested in skiing more than one day a week? Is your racer 9 years or older and you want to do a little traveling and compete in the North Series races? If you answered yes to either of these questions the North Series Team may be for you.

**Alpine North Series Team** - Is designed for ages 9 and up (8 with coach's recommendation) wanting to pursue ski racing while traveling on a limited basis. This program is for athletes with basic racing skills who enjoying racing and want to train and compete two-three days per week. North Series members will compete in the Intermountain North Series races at Bogus Basin, Sun Valley and Kelly Canyon.

**Team Shred Home** – Is designed for athletes 9 and older with basic skiing or snowboarding skills. This program is focused on advanced big mountain skiing development and other freestyle disciplines such as moguls and park. This program is designed to develop a well rounded all mountain athlete by providing a fun and safe learning environment. Participants may choose the basic Saturday or Sunday program.

**Team Shred Competition Team** – Is designed for athletes (age 13 and older), this program is focused on advanced freeride and freestyle disciplines in a fun and safe learning environment. Early season and specialized event training and may require travel to other resorts (additional fees will apply). The competition team trains 3-4 days each week during the ski season. More details will follow and a competition schedule will be announced when it is available. To offer this program we must have ten or more members.

**Ski Cross Team** - Is a two day (Saturday & Sunday) program for those that want to train for both ski racing and freeride. Members will train one day with the Alpine Development team and one day with Team Shred.

**Varsity Team Program** – Is designed for athletes (age 13 and older), this program is focused on advanced alpine race skiing development. Athletes in this program train five days per week and compete throughout the Intermountain Division of the USSA. Athletes travel to races with coaches and team members.

Assumption of Risk and Release of Liability**

**Read the following warnings carefully before signing this form. This is a waiver of certain legal rights:**

Ski and snowboard competitions involve **many inherent risks, dangers and hazards**. These risks, dangers and hazards may exist at any time and at any place in and around the competition course or facility. They may threaten not only the competitors themselves, but may also threaten me as a competition worker.

Due to high speeds, slick surfaces and icy conditions, you will be at risk of being struck by competitors and/or runaway equipment. While you **must pay close attention to the intervals between competitors**, you must also be aware that such intervals are sometimes irregular. You must **pay special attention to competitor fall zones and likely trajectories of competitors** who may lose control and/or fall. If you have any questions or concerns about fall zones and/or trajectories, you should inquire with a member of the Competition Jury.

The Competition Jury is responsible for controlling the competition. You must comply with instructions of the Jury regarding opening and closing of courses, and regarding your positioning on the course. However, given the unpredictability of ski and snowboard competition and the winter mountain environment, following the advice of Competition Jury members or any other person **does not and cannot guarantee your safety**. If you believe that complying with a Competition Jury instruction would expose you to risk of injury, you should clearly state your concern to a Jury member and state your intention not to follow the instruction.

Competition equipment may be cumbersome and heavy. Exercise caution in carrying and handling such equipment to avoid injury from strain or exertion, particularly when working on steep and uneven terrain. Also, pay attention to climatic conditions and protect yourself from exposure and dehydration.

Side-slipping of race courses involves many of the risks and dangers inherent in the sport of skiing. These risks may be exacerbated by short time periods between racers in which side-slipping must be completed. If you lack advanced skiing skills or are otherwise unwilling to assume the risks inherent in this activity, do not participate in side-slipping of courses.

Consumption of alcohol or illegal drugs by race workers in BBSEF competitions is strictly prohibited.

**By affixing my signature below, I represent that I am over the age of eighteen (18) years, have read the foregoing warnings and in spite of the risks, dangers and hazards involved in such activities, I nevertheless choose to volunteer my services as a BBSEF Race/Event Worker. By so doing, I agree to release, indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the Bogus Basin Ski Education Foundation, its employees, affiliates, insurers, and sponsors from any and all claims arising from my participation as a race worker. I also understand and agree that as a volunteer I am not entitled to workers compensation coverage for injuries arising from my participation in these activities and agree not to seek coverage under BBSEF's workers compensation insurance.**
